Lehigh Valley Health Network plans major improvements in area

HAZLETON — Lehigh Valley Health Network plans to expand and modernize its hospital in the city, of fer increased services from an enlarged ExpressCARE facility in the downtown and "significantly" expand the Health & Wellness Center and its services in neighboring Hazle Twp., the hospital president told the city health services authority board Tuesday.


Assuring the authority that Lehigh Valley remains committed to Hazleton, hospital president John Fletcher said they could expect expansion and modernization of local facilities in the future.

"Our hospital is going to stay in Hazleton," Fletcher told the board.

Plans are under development for "modernization" of the hospital campus in Hazleton, which include "significant expansion" of the emergency department and upgrades that are intended to convert most, if not all, rooms at the hospital into private rooms, he said.
