## ENFORCEMENT



ORDINANCE 2012-25 (As Amended by Ordinance 2013-5)

Establishment of a Registration and Licensure Program for All Properties, All Institutional Occupancies, and Daycare

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF** hereby ordained and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. INTENT


It is the purpose of this Ordinance and the policy of the City of Hazleton, promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens, to establish of owners and occupants relating to tenant occupied residential rental un facilities, and daycare facilities. As a means to those ends, this Ordinance of inspections, issuance and renewal of occupancy licenses, and sets pena also sets forth requirements of all owners of tenant occupied residential u agent for service of process, and prescribes duties of owners and agents.
